- PLACE READILY VISIBLE SIGNAGE AT THE BUSINESS OF BEST HYGIENE PRACTICES.
- FOLLOW STATE AND CITY REGULATIONS ON AMOUNT OF PATRONS ALLOWED INSIDE.
- CONTACTLESS PAYMENT IS ENCOURAGED.

Prepare a Social Distancing Protocol

- YOU MUST COMPLY WITH ALL SOCIAL DISTANCING REQUIREMENTS.
- CONSIDER DEDICATING A CERTAIN TIME OF EACH DAY FOR ONLY AT-RISK CUSTOMERS OR DELIVER GOODS TO VEHICLES TO REDUCE THE NEED FOR AT-RISK CUSTOMERS TO ENTER THE STORE.

Drop Off/Pick Up

Face Coverings

 CONSISTANT WITH THE ACTIONS TAKEN BY MOST RETAILERS, CONSIDER HAVING ALL EMPLOYEES WEAR FACE COVERINGS.

Keep It Clean

- DISINFECT ANY ITEMS THAT COME INTO CONTACT WITH CUSTOMERS.
- REGULARLY DISINFECT HIGH-TOUCH SURFACES AND HANDLES. TRAIN ALL EMPLOYEES AND CONTRACTORS ON APPROPRIATE CLEANING AND DISINFECTION, HAND HYGIENE, AND RESPITORY ETIQUETTE.

REMINDER

- This business must provide sanitation supplies accessible and available to all employee.
- This business WILL mandate that employees clean and sanitize all work areas of the business, including vehicles, at least twice during the workday.
- Before beginning work, this business/organization WILL screen all employees and send home any employee showing signs of illness
