

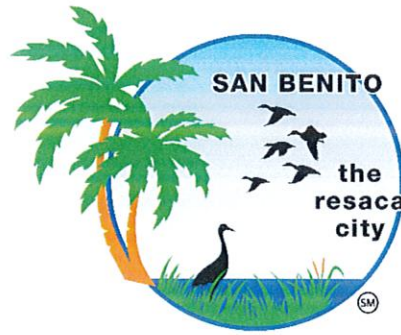

Notice is hereby given that Election Code Section 31.122 requires for the city secretary to keep their office open for at least three hours each day during regular office hours, on regular business days during the period running from the 50<sup>th</sup> day before election day until the 40<sup>th</sup> day after election day.

For purposes of Election Code 31.122, for an entity other than the ISD, "regular business day" means any weekday that is not considered a legal state or national holiday under Election Code 1.006.

Through City offices are closed in observance of Good Friday holiday, in accordance with the Election Code, the Office of the City Secretary will be open three hours on April 7, 2023 for election business. Please note that other routine services of the City Secretary, such as public information, will not be available during these limited holiday hours.
